Wellbeing

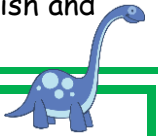

Integrated Studies

Dinosaurs and More

During this biological science unit students learn about prehistoric animals, palaeontology, the habitats, diet and features of dinosaurs. At the end students will create their own dinosaur, habitat, write and present an information report. This will be integrated into English and Mathematics.



Mathematics

Throughout this term, students will be using materials to measure the length and mass of objects. They will explore the features of 2D & 3D shapes, the days of the week and months of the year. In Number they will continue to explore addition and subtraction and use materials such as 10 frames and number lines to represent.
