Mathematics

Explicit learning and assessment will focus on:

Place Value - whole numbers
 & decimals

Statistics and Probability

- Creating survey questions & tally results
- Graphing data
- Interpreting results
- Chance & probability language and recognising the probability of events occurring

Literacy

Explicit learning will focus on:

Literacy Skills

- Word-level reading & fluency
- Spelling & Morphology
- Grammar
- Typing skills
- Language Features (hyperboles, similes, metaphors, rhetorical questions, antonyms and synonyms)
- Text structure for a Narrative,
 Recount & Exposition text
- Writing techniques ('Show, Don't Tell', sizzling starts & funnelling ideas)

Integrated Studies

Cultural celebrations from around the world . Including:

- The Basant Kite festival
- St Patricks Day
- Bastille Day
- Diwali
- Dia de los Muertos (Day of the Dead)

Students will develop an understanding for the reason of the celebration, how it is celebrated & the symbols representing the celebration.

Term 1 begins with our Start-Up program which focusses on building relationships between students and teachers. We will be participating in weekly Wellbeing lessons and activities that will promote and support a positive learning community. With our Respectful Relationships curriculum we will be looking at the topics of 'Emotional Literacy' and 'Growth Mindset'. We will also explore the Zones of Regulation.
