Homework Expectations

15 minutes + daily reading out loud to an adult: To be recorded in school diary and signed by an adult. Reading nights will be checked by the classroom teacher and take home readers changed once a week.

Show and Tell preparation: Students will be sent home with a specific show and tell topic and a show and tell date

Reading rewards will be given by the classroom teacher when students have reached a milestone (every 25 nights, eg: 75 nights)

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Indonesian

In Indonesian this term we will be:

Revising how to ask 'What is your name?' and answering with 'My name is.....'; 'What is his/her name?' and answering with 'His/Her name is.....' and 'How are you?' with responses to how you are feeling

Revising greetings such as Good Morning, Good Afternoon, hello and goodbye

Continuing to learn about food in Indonesia and words for foods in Indonesian and expressing likes and dislikes of foods

Putting all of the above language into a role play situation with Indonesian costume and/or the use of Indonesian puppets

Continuing to learn about Indonesia as a country; including its people, culture and traditions



Technology

During Term Three, students will be exposed to a variety of different activities both teacher and student led where students will be supported to work with their peers to problem solve and learn new skills. Students will be encouraged to identify things that are important to them and they are passionate about and will be encouraged to share with the class what they have been working on in the session.

Physical Education

During Term Three, the main focus for students will again be building on their fundamental motor skills (catch, throw, bounce, kick) and locomotor skills (hop, jump, skip, run, crawl). We will practise performing locomotor movements using different body parts and demonstrate balances and describe what helps to maintain stable positions. Students will participate in games to show these skills and will further develop our skills around turn-taking and sharing equipment.



Library / Wellbeing

This term in Library / Wellbeing Grade 1/2 will have lessons each **Wednesday** where they are encouraged to return and borrow books. Our focus in Library will be listening to a story each week by an Australian Author. During the Wellbeing sessions students will be exploring different emotions and strategies they can use through activities in Smiling Mind, Zones of Regulation, Managing Emotion tasks and Circle Time.
